RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT

Item 1 Operations and Maintenance Services

The Administrative Unit will provide a brief overview of the current status of the three air quality monitoring stations in Ciudad Juárez. To ensure that the three monitoring stations in Ciudad Juárez continue to operate under a contractual agreement for operations and maintenance services, the Administrative Unit recommends the Fund Committee approve a six-month contract with Autonomous University of Ciudad Juarez in the amount of \$27,505.48 USD.

Item 2 Defining the process for Technical Commission Membership

In the event of changes to or within the agencies represented on the Administrative Unit, the Administrative Unit recommends to define the process for appointing new members. It is proposed that the member agencies notify the Air Policy Workgroups Co-Chairs of any substitution or changes to their membership. For new members to be added to the administrative unit it is proposed for a motion to be made and approved by the Joint Advisory Committee and request that the Air Policy Workgroup Co-Chairs solicit designees from the members approved. Per the resolution, the administrative unit is limited to six members.
